#### TDB39 Town Investment Plan – Stage 1

The Director – Regeneration and Housing, Nuneaton and Bedworth Borough Council (NBBC), submitted a report to provide the Board with information contained within the Town Investment Plan Templates, in relation to the content required for the Town Investment Plan (TIP).

Detailed guidance in relation to the Towns Fund programme was issued on 16th June 2020. A summary of that guidance was presented to Board at its meeting of 19th June, 2020. On 9th July, 2020, the TIP templates were published, as provided at Appendix A to the report.

The Board was informed that Julian Pye of Arup had been appointed as Nuneaton's Towns Fund Delivery Partner (TFDP) by the Ministry for Housing, Communities and Local Government (MHCLG). Julian would be invited to attend future meetings of the Board. Section 3.3 of the report listed the type of support available from the TFDP to help the Board develop the TIP and business cases.

# TDB42 Town's Fund Grant – Capital Projects Delivery By 31st March 2021

The Director – Regeneration and Housing (NBBC) submitted a report to provide the Board with information relating to the potential award of £1m advanced funding from the Towns Fund, for capital projects that could be completed by 31<sup>st</sup> March 2020.

The funding was for capital projects only, must be spent by 31<sup>st</sup> March 2020 and be used for projects that support towns in responding to immediate challenges, including;

- improvements to or new parks and green spaces and sustainable transport links;
- improvements to town centres including repurposing empty commercial properties;
- demolition or site remediation where this will have an immediate benefit.

The Board welcomed the funding and requested that when available, business cases be shared with members, especially for the the Co-op development.

The following matters were also raised by members for further consideration and response by the Director – Housing and Regeneration (NBBC):

- projects with a possible emphasis on youth and those graduating from colleges and schools where employment will be challenging, and opportunities for post 16 year olds to set up their own businesses;
- how many jobs might be created and if there were any interactions with Job Centre Plus.

Offers of help to deliver projects were made by representatives on behalf of Warwickshire County Council and the Coventry and Warwickshire Local Enterprise Partnership.

- b) once prepared, the business cases for the Co-op, and other projects, be shared with Board members;
- c) a Towns Fund project plan be finalised and provided to the Board.
