BYELAW

made under Section 235 of the Local Government Act 1972 by Nuneaton and Bedworth Borough Council with respect to the riding of bicycles or similar machines on pedestrianised areas in the Borough of Nuneaton and Bedworth.

Insofar as the Council of the Borough of Nuneaton and Bedworth may indicate by notices exhibited at the entrances to any of the pedestrianised areas described in the Schedule to this byelaw that the riding of bicycles, tricycles or similar machines in such areas is prohibited, no person shall ride any such bicycle, tricycle or any similar machine upon any such pedestrianised area.

Any person who offends against this byelaw shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding the sum of fifty pounds for each offence.
