

BYE-LAWS

Made and ordained by the Nuneaton Board of Health, pursuant to the Powers and Provisions of the Public Health Act, 1848, and the Local Government Act, 1858.

1.—THAT all the bye-laws made by this board in 1851 and 1855 be and the same are hereby repealed from and after the making and confirmation of the bye-laws hereinafter set forth.

2.—That the regular monthly meetings of this Board shall be held at the TOWN HALL, NUNEATON, or at such other place as the said Board shall from time to time order and direct, on the first Thursday in each month, at two o'clock in the afternoon, and that the members present shall have power to adjourn any such meeting if they think fit.

5.—That the ordinary business of the Board shall be disposed of at the monthly meetings previous to any motion being discussed.

6.—That no motion shall be made at any meeting of the Board except a special meeting, called as aforesaid, unless notice thereof shall have been given at a previous meeting, and no notice of motion shall be given at any other than a regular monthly meeting.

STREETS.

With respect to the level, width, and construction of New Streets, and the provisions for the Sewerage thereof.

1.—Every new street shall be laid out and formed of such width and at such level as the said Board shall in each case determine.

Every new street, being a carriage road, shall be laid out and formed at least thirty-six feet wide, and the said Board shall determine in each case what proportion of the width of such street shall be laid out as carriage-way and foot-way respectively.
