## BYE-LAW

*made by the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the  
Borough of Nuneaton, acting by the Council.*

From and after the date of the confirmation of this Byelaw—

(a) the byelaws specified in the First Schedule which are already in force in part of the said Borough shall apply to the whole Borough:

(b) the byelaws specified in the Second Schedule which, by the operation of the Borough of Nuneaton (Extension) Order, 1931, lapsed on the first day of April, 1932, shall be re-enacted and shall, subject to the following provisions, apply to the whole Borough:—

the series of byelaws with respect to tents, vans, sheds and similar structures used for human habitation shall be deemed to apply to tents, vans, sheds and similar structures used for human habitation which are used only as regular dwelling-places:

the following byelaw shall be substituted for byelaws 2 (two) and 3 (three) in the series of byelaws with respect to common lodging-houses:—

“ A keeper of a common lodging-house shall not, at any one time, receive into any room therein used as a sleeping apartment a greater number of lodgers than will allow *three hundred and sixty* cubic feet of free air space for each person of an age exceeding ten years, and *two hundred and fifty* cubic feet of free air space for each person of an age not exceeding ten years.”

(c) The byelaws specified in the Third Schedule which, by the operation of the above-mentioned Order, lapsed on the first day of April, 1932, shall be re-enacted and shall, for a period of two years from the date of the confirmation of this byelaw, continue to apply, unless repealed or altered by the Town Council of Nuneaton, in the Borough of Nuneaton as it existed immediately before the first day of April 1931.
