2. EXCLUSIVE RIGHTS OF BURIAL IN EARTHEN GRAVES.				
For the exclusive right of burial in perpetuity in an earthen grave and including the cost of the first interment therein:				
(a)	9 ft. by 4 ft. and not exceeding 9 ft. in depth to contain not more than 3 coffins	4	4	0
(b)	5 ft. 6 ins. by 3 ft. 6 ins. (intended for the interment only of the bodies of persons whose age at the time of death did not exceed 12 years) not to exceed 7 ft. 6 ins. in depth and to contain not more than 2 coffins	2	2	0

3. WALLED GRAVES AND VAULTS.

For the right to construct, including the exclusive right of burial therein in perpetuity including the first interment :

- (a) A walled grave :
 - 9 ft. by 4 ft. not exceeding 9 ft. in depth and to contain not more than three coffins 7 7
- (b) A vault :
 - 9 ft. by 8 ft. not exceeding 9 ft. in depth and to contain not more than three coffins 15 15

4. MONUMENTS, GRAVESTONES, ~~TABLETS AND MONUMENTAL INSCRIPTIONS~~

For the right to erect or place—

- (A) A flat stone occupying a superficial area :
 - (i) Not exceeding 7 ft. by 2 ft. 9 ins. 3 0 0
 - (ii) Exceeding 7 ft. by 2 ft. 9 ins. but not exceeding 7 ft. by 6 ft. 6 ins. 5 0 0
- (B) A headstone :
 - (i) Not exceeding 3 ft. 6 ins. in height, 2 ft. 9 ins. in width, or 5 ins. in thickness at the base 1 1 0
 - (ii) Exceeding 3 ft. 6 ins. but not exceeding 5 ft. in height, or exceeding 5 ins. in thickness but not exceeding 15 ins. in thickness at the base and not exceeding 2 ft. 9 ins. in width 2 2 0
 - (iii) Exceeding 5 ft. but not exceeding 6 ft. in height or exceeding 15 ins. in thickness at the base or exceeding 3 ft. in width 3 3 0
 - (iv) Exceeding 6 ft. but not exceeding 7 ft. in height or exceeding 3ft. but not exceeding 3 ft. 3 ins. in width 4 4 0
- (C) A footstone :
 - (i) not exceeding 2 feet in height and a base thickness not exceeding 6 ins. 1 0 0
- (D) Kerb stones or border stones enclosing a space not exceeding 7 ft. by 2 ft. 9 ins. :
 - (i) not exceeding 8 ins. in height 1 0 0
 - (ii) exceeding 8 ins. in height 1 10 0
- (E) Any monument or gravestone not previously specified and not exceeding 7 ft. 3 ins. long by 3 ft. 3 ins. wide :
 - (i) on an earthen or walled grave 6 6 0
 - (ii) on a vault 7 7 0

The foregoing fees, payments and sums will be doubled where the person to be interred or in respect of whom the right is granted is, or was immediately before his death, not an inhabitant or parishioner of the Borough of Nuneaton or, in the case of a still-born child, where neither of the parents is, or was at the time of interment, such an inhabitant or parishioner.

The foregoing table of fees, payments and sums was adopted by the Borough Council of Nuneaton at a meeting held on the 27th June, 1950.
