

- BYELAWS. -
(BURIAL GROUNDS)


BYELAWS made by the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Nuneaton acting by the Council as the Burial Board for the regulation of the Burial Grounds belonging to them.

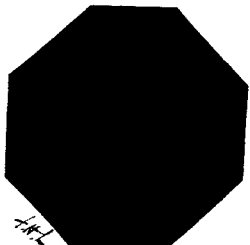
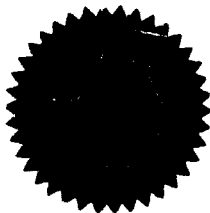
1. "Council" means the Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Nuneaton acting as the Burial Board for the district of the said Borough.
- "Burial Ground" means the Burial Grounds belonging to the Council and situate at Oaston Road, Nuneaton; Lutterworth Road, Attleborough, Nuneaton; and Bucks Hill, Stockingford, Nuneaton.
2. A person shall not in the Burial Ground canvass or solicit orders.
3. Every person who offends against the foregoing byelaw Numbered 2 (two) shall be liable for every such offence to a penalty of five pounds.

Provided, nevertheless, that the justices or Court before whom any complaint may be made or any proceedings may be taken in respect of any such offence may, if they think fit, adjudge the payment as a penalty of any sum less than the full amount of the penalty imposed by this byelaw.
