RECORD OF THE DECISION

a) The issue:

The Council is required to maintain its properties to a safe and decent standard. External capacity from a competent contractor is required to undertake general building works, to ensure requirements are complied with.

b) The Decision:

To appoint a contractor to undertake general building works.

REASON FOR THE DECISION

The Council has an obligation to ensure its properties are kept in a good and safe standard and comply to the decent home standards and Housing Health and Safety Rating System (HHSRS). Given capacity issues, and the types of some required works (e,g, structural works) which have been exacerbated by the introduction of new regulations, additional capacity is required to ensure those regulations are complied with.

ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS CONSIDERED AND REJECTED IN MAKING THE DECISION

The internal Direct Labour Organisation could complete works, however, more technical structural works are outside of current skill sets, procedures and equipment. Additionally, the increased demand, coupled with recruitment difficulties mean that there is insufficient capacity within internal resources. Therefore, this option was rejected, and an external contractor was procured via a framework.
