RECORD OF THE DECISION

a) The issue

NABCEL were awarded the contract for the Building Cleaning Contract (Corporate) for Nuneaton and Bedworth Borough Council (NBBC) in April 2022. The contract was extended for a 12-month period in 2024 which expired on 31.03.25.

Subsequently, NABCEL are currently out of contract and are seeking the reinstatement of the Building Cleaning Contract (Corporate) for NBBC based on a 2 year agreement.

b) The Decision

To award the contract to NABCEL using a direct award procurement route without competition by means of an exemption as per the regulations as an award made by a contracting authority to 'a legal person' under Regulation 12 of the Public Contract Regulations 2015 (teckal) or Schedule 2 of the Procurement Act 2023 (vertical arrangement). NABCEL is wholly owned by the Council which is a model used by many other local authorities across the Country.

REASON FOR THE DECISION

It is considered that the NABCEL contract represents the best value for money options and ensures consistency in the service provision

ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS CONSIDERED AND REJECTED IN MAKING THE DECISION

Complete a full competitive Tender for the Corporate cleaning contract. But given the competitive pricing provide by NABCEL and avoid any gap in the service provision the best option provided was to continue with a revised contract for the current cleaning provision.
