# RECORD OF THE DECISION

- a) The issue NBBC have been made aware that following National Grid's (NG) assessment of the Pingles substation in preparation of a new connection / substation for the decarbonisation project/equipment. There are power fluctuations at the site of 38/39% which are far outside of NG tolerance levels of 5%.
- b) Due to the power fluctuations NG have detailed they will connect the new power supply but will NOT allow the connection of the new decarbonisation equipment until these fluctuations are brought within their 5% levels.
- c) The project has tight timescales to complete the project, install and commission and draw down the final elements of funding from Gov't / Salix prior to March 2026.NG have also confirmed their timescales for the new connection and if this is delayed, the project will be delayed, therefore.
- d) NBBC need to act quickly and install an Active Harmonic Filtration, to address the tolerance levels and allow the decarbonisation to be completed and enable the reopening of the site (with the new decarb equipment) for use by the public.
- e) The project contractor (Asset Plus) has been asked to provide the solution to the issues at the Pingles and have this signed off by NG meeting their requirements.

# REASON FOR THE DECISION

To ensure a suitable supplier is appointed to support NBBC waste operational requirements, whilst maintaining cost efficiency.
