# RECORD OF THE DECISION

#### a) The issue

NBBC is a Landlord via its Housing Revenue Account (HRA) and operationally it is required to repair and maintain electrical appliances and replace where the appliances are beyond economical repair or inefficient. In addition NBBC needs to carry out regular EICR checks on all its properties.

Currently, this service is provided by NABCEL and the Council must now agree a mechanism to continue the provision of these services.

#### b) The Decision

Reprocure NABCEL to manage the repair and maintenance of electrical appliances and carrying out EICRs on all NBBC properties.

#### REASON FOR THE DECISION

NBBC is required to ensure electrical appliances are repaired and maintained appropriately and EICR checks are carried out to protect our tenants. NABCEL are managing the current repairs & maintenance programme and EICR programme.

### ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS CONSIDERED AND REJECTED IN MAKING THE DECISION

An open tender process was considered. However, NBBC have recently, had the electrical repairs and maintenance contract re-procured which NABCEL is managing and an open tender would require that contract to stop. This was, therefore, not a feasible option.
