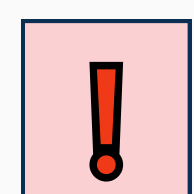
Most measures have a favourable direction, either increase or decrease. There are exceptions which have no favourable direction. These are monitored to understand demand on a service.



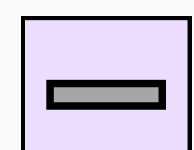
Good performance (Tick) – The performance measure has changed in the favourable direction.



Within Tolerance (Triangle) – The performance measure has changed in the unfavourable direction but within 2.5% threshold.



Area for improvement (Exclamation Mark) – The performance measure has changed in the unfavourable direction and exceeds the 2.5% threshold.



No Change (Dash) – The performance measure is unchanged from the same period last financial year.



No direction (Clipboard) – The performance measure is monitored to understand demand on services

For the majority of performance measures, targets are set each financial year. These performance measures are then classified as one of three statuses based on how it compares with the target.



Performing Well (Green) – The performance measure is meeting or beating its target.



Area for improvement (Red) – The performance measure is not yet at its target.



No Target Defined (Light Stone) – The performance measure is monitored to understand demand on services but the council does not judge them against a target.

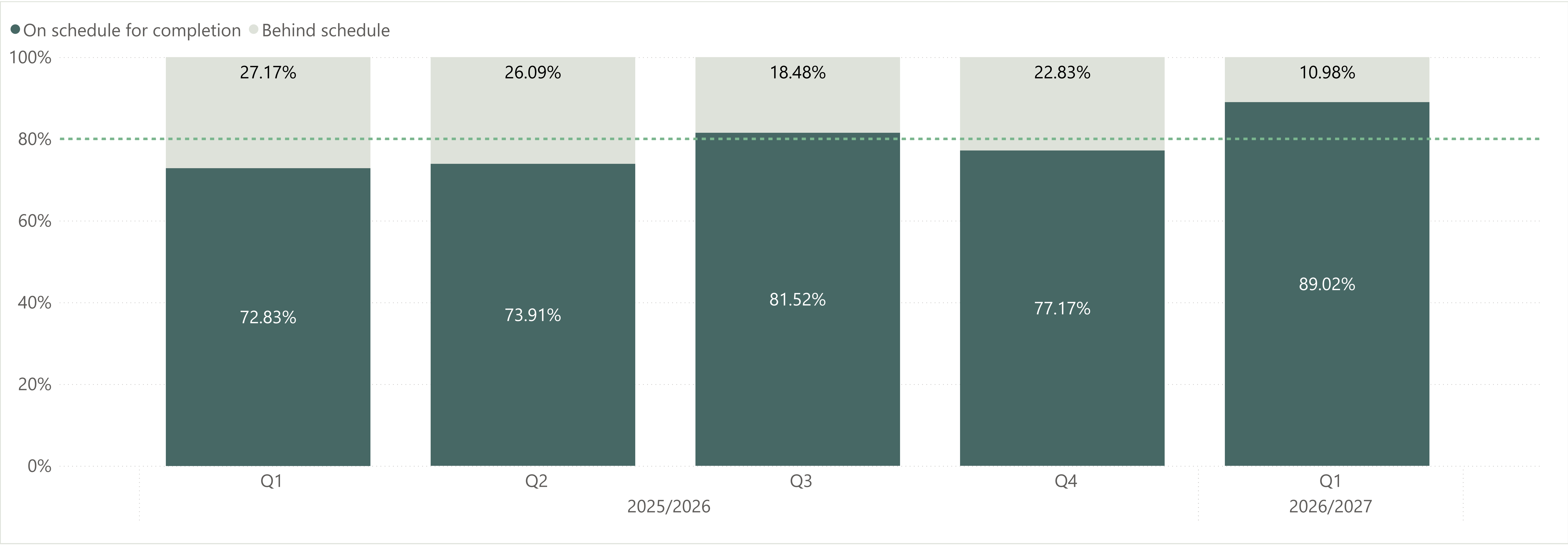

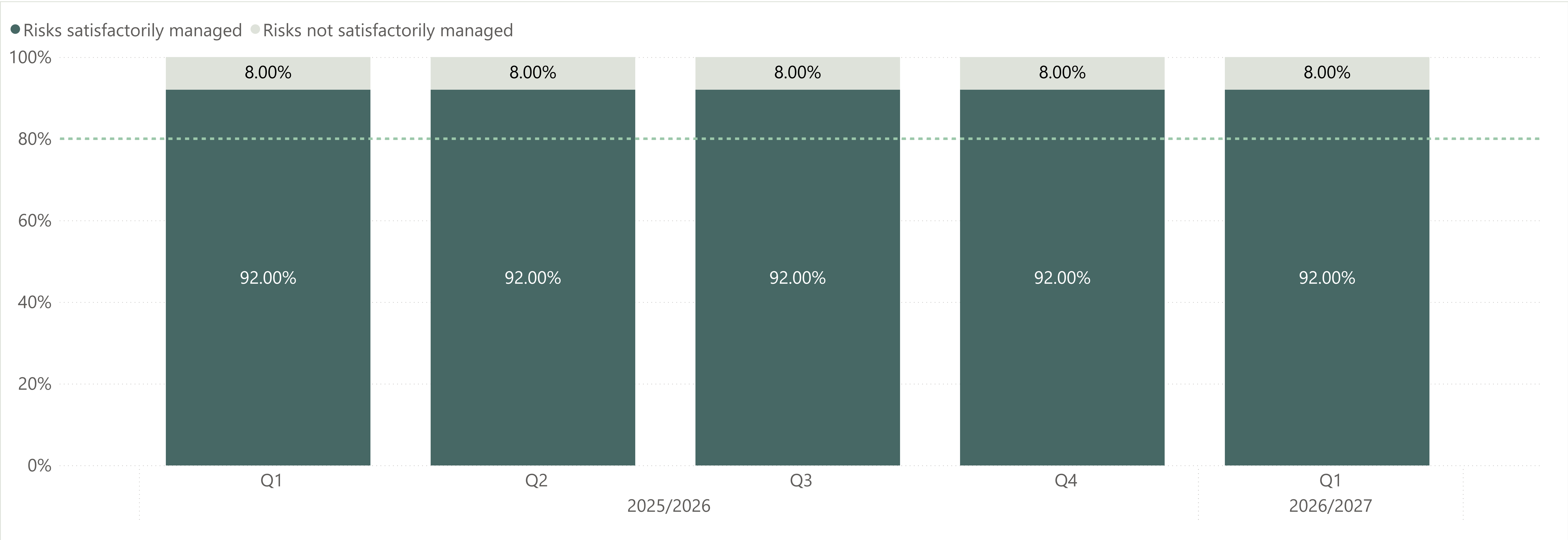

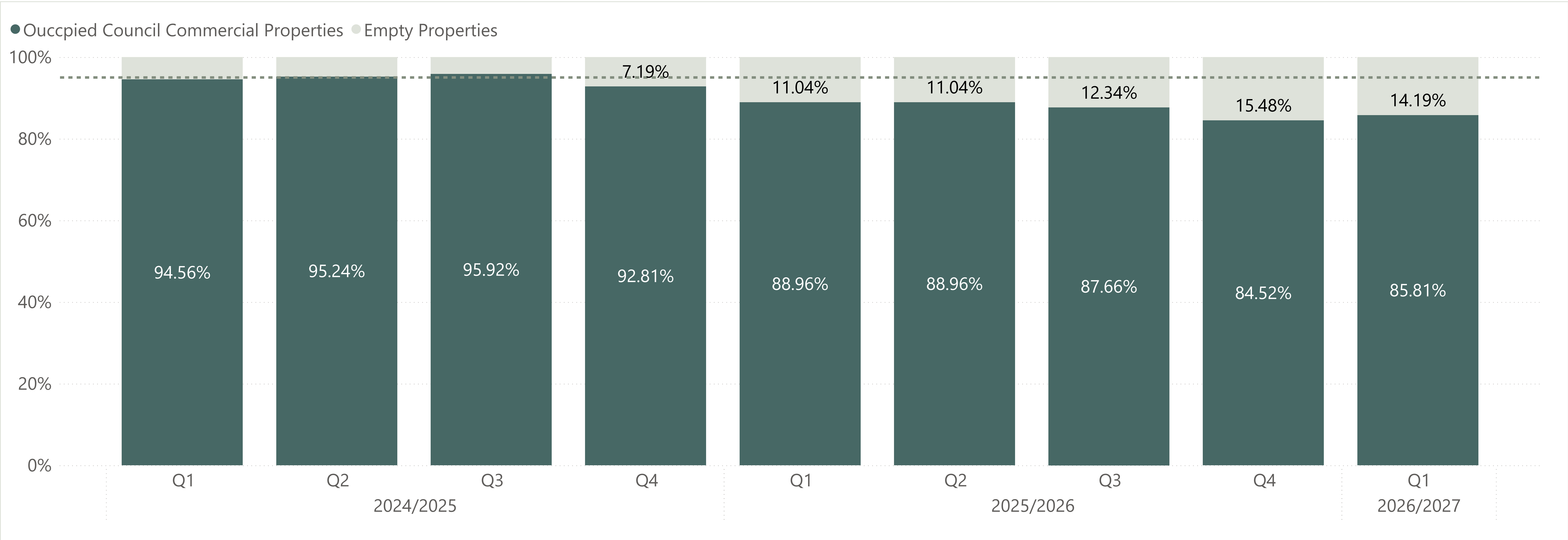

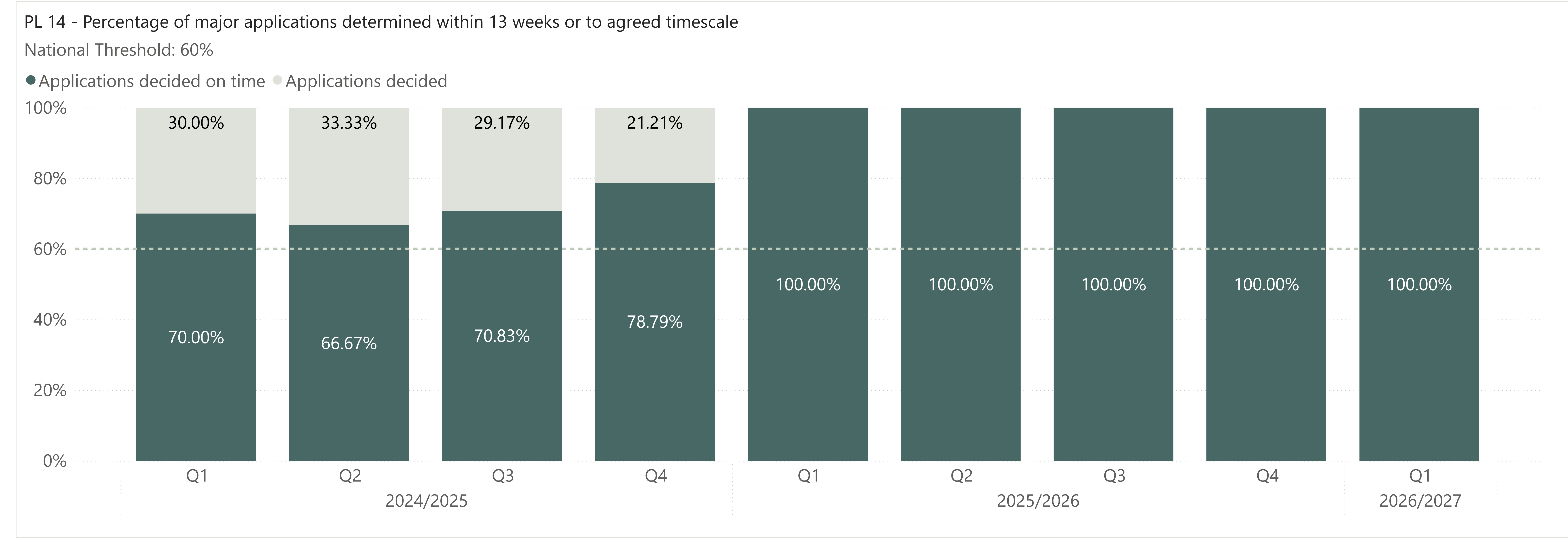

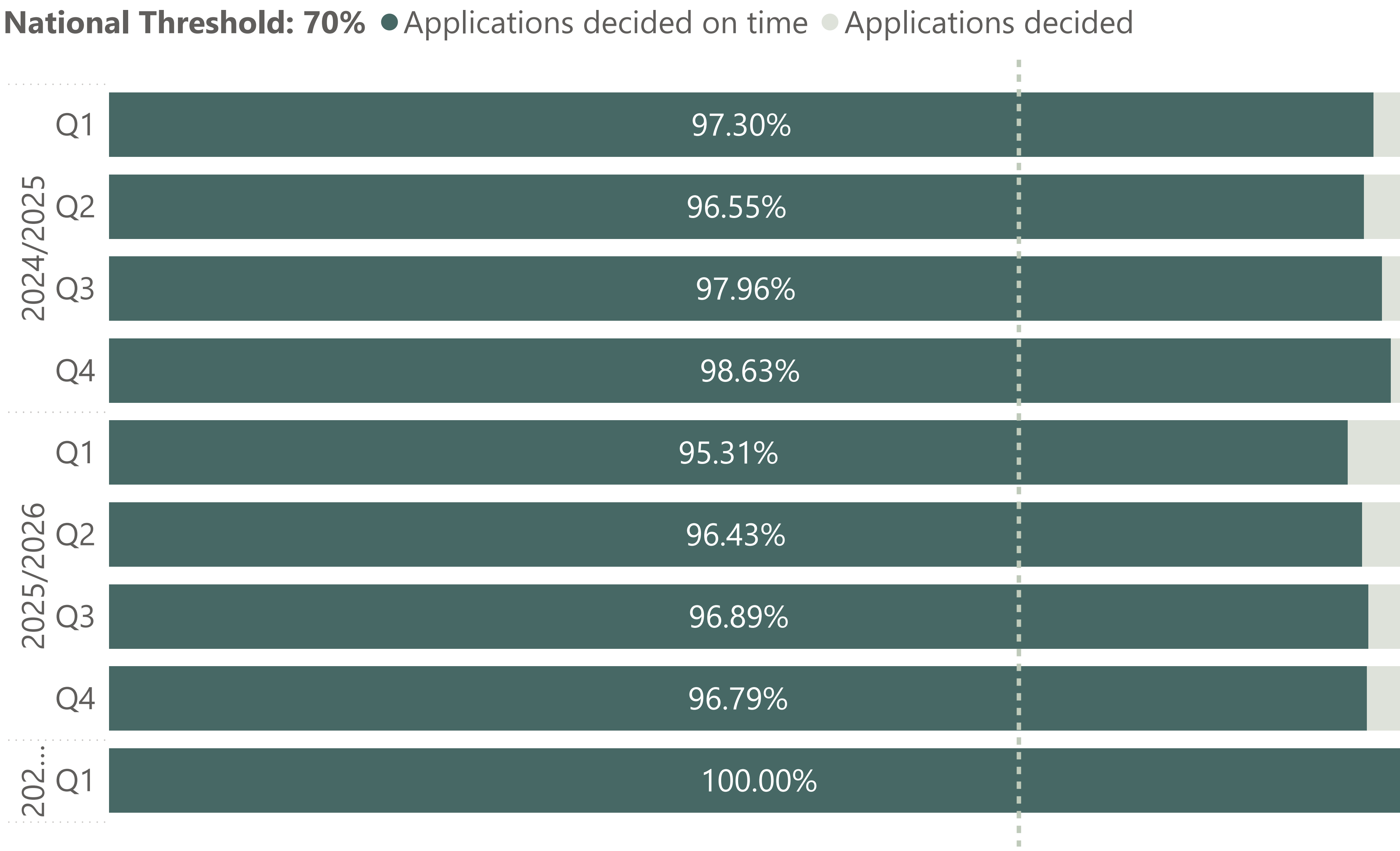

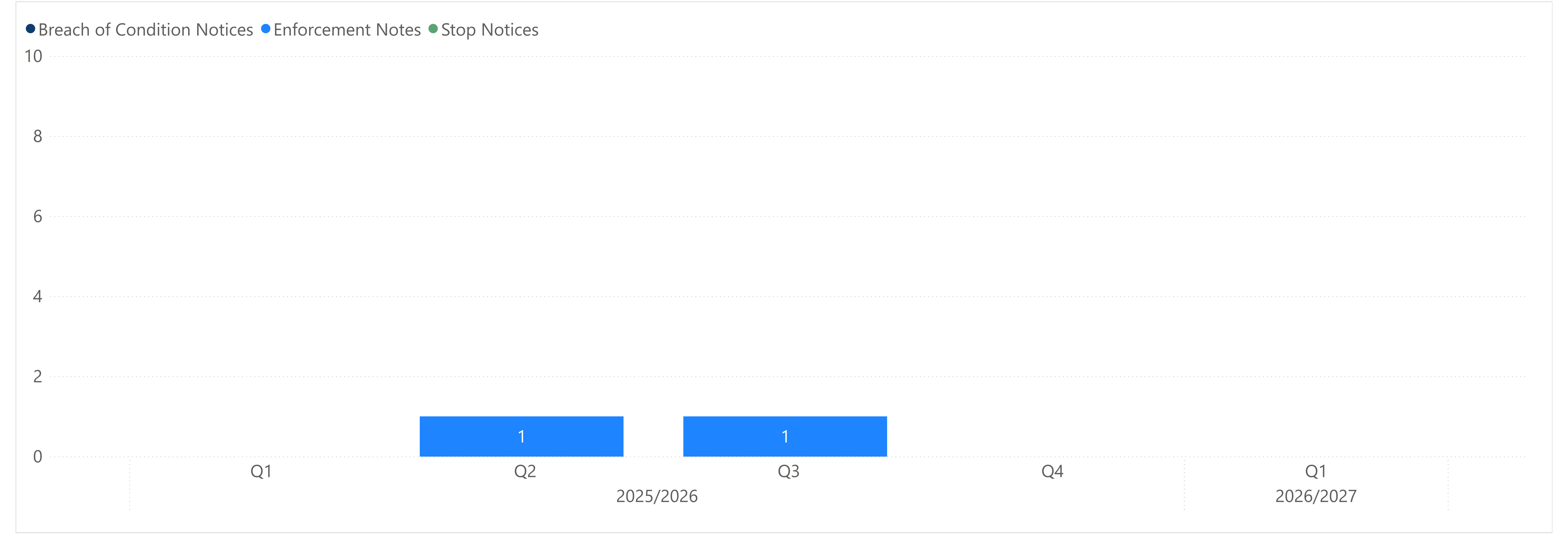

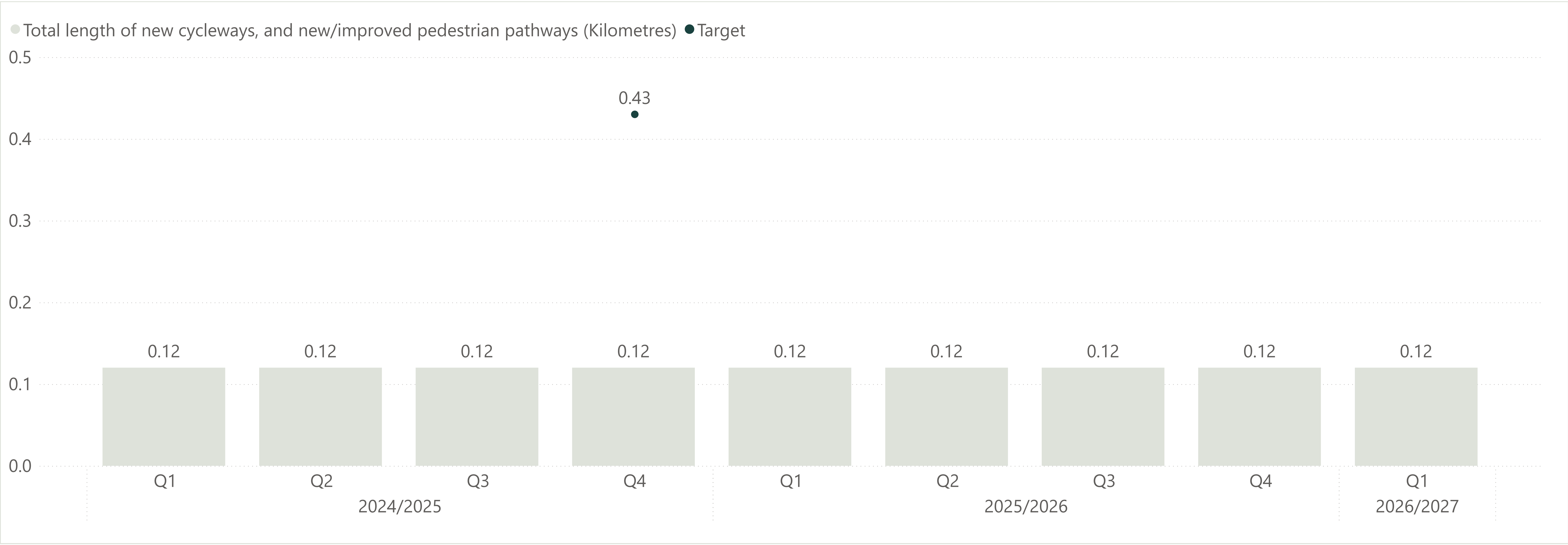

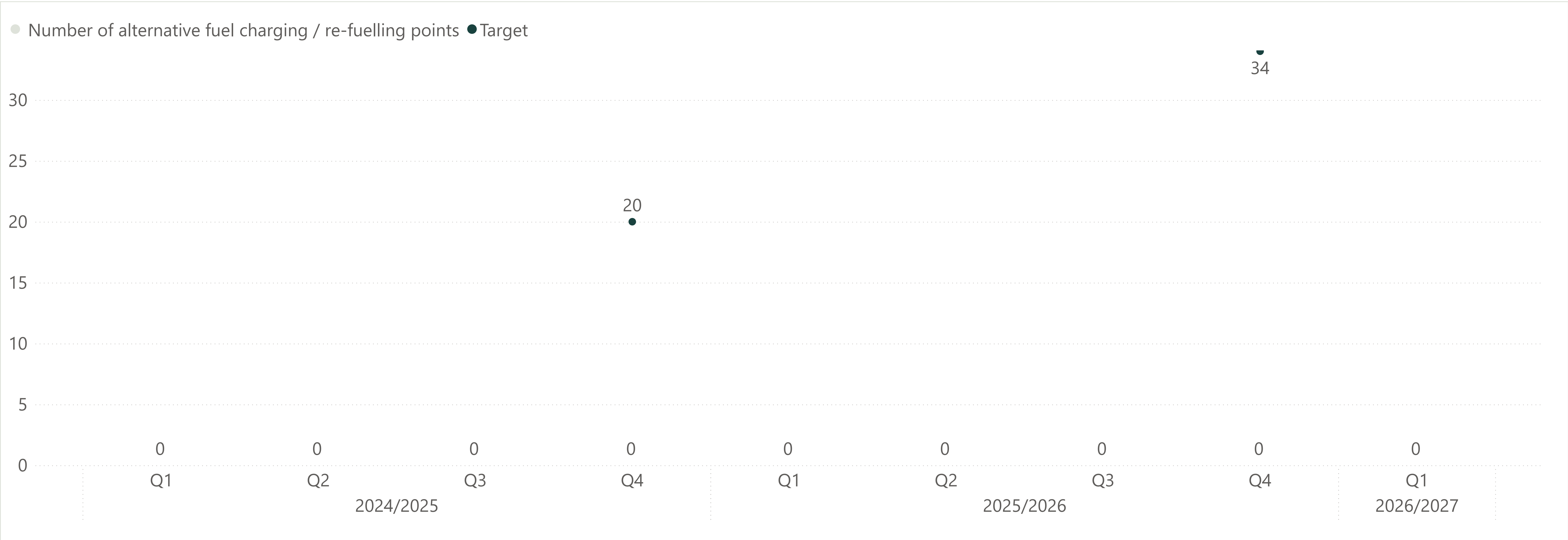

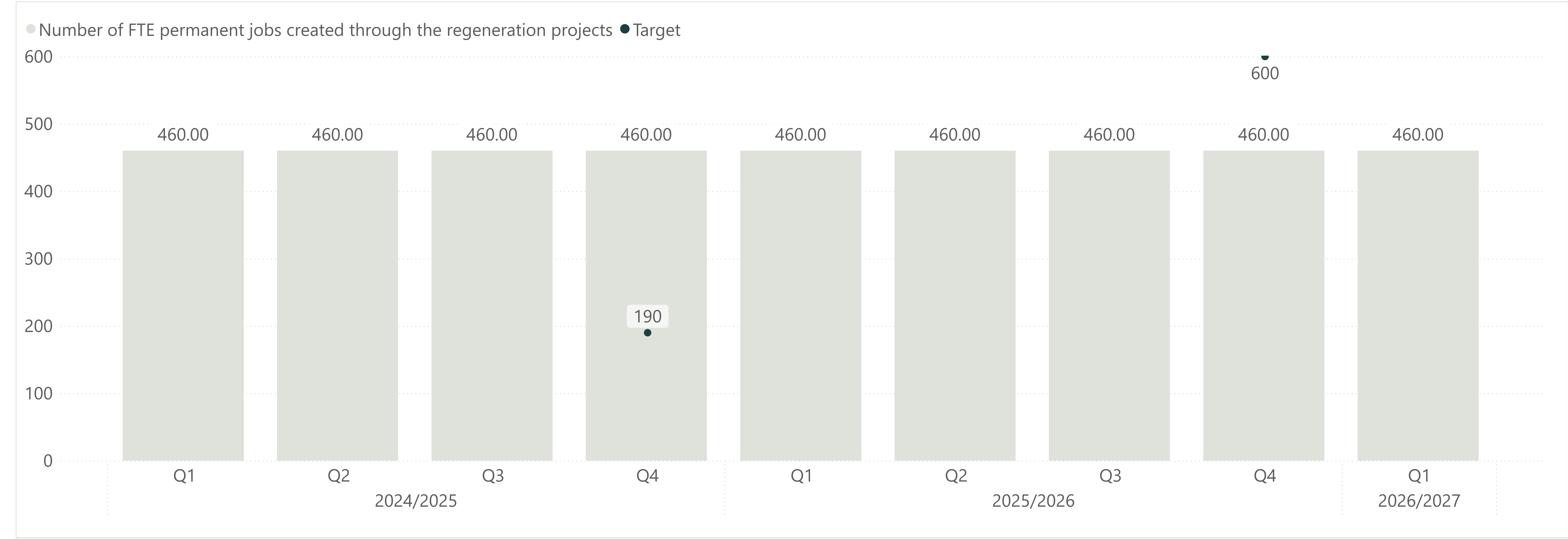

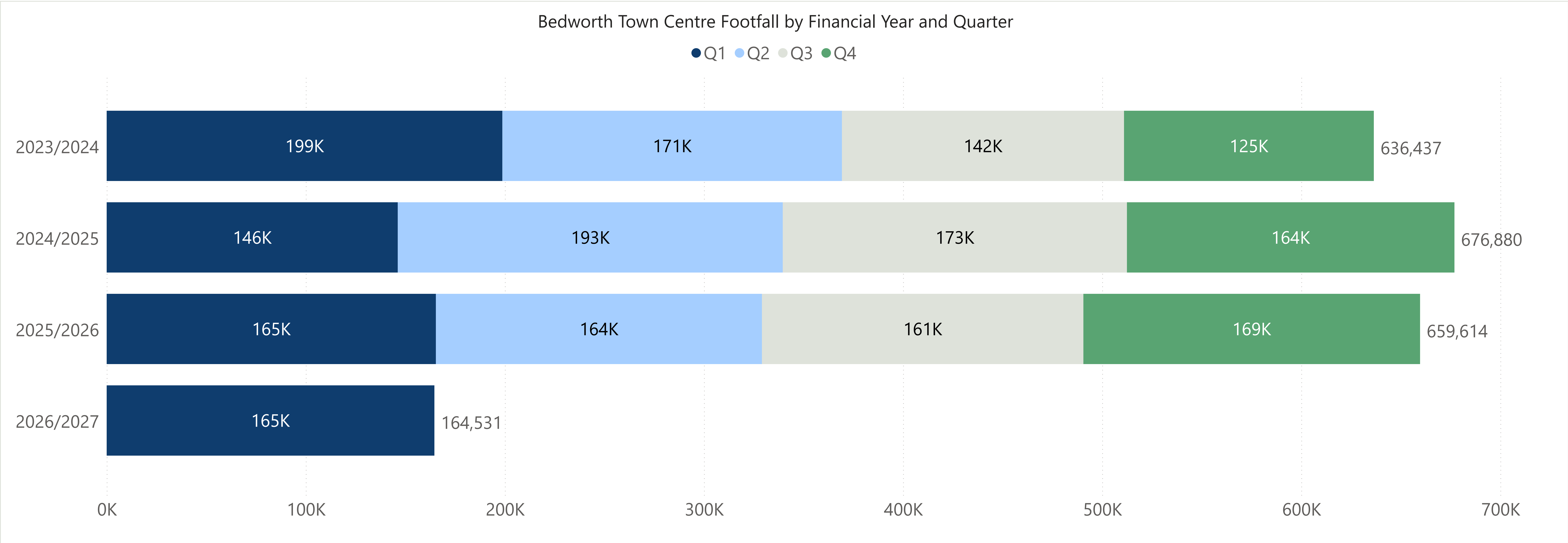

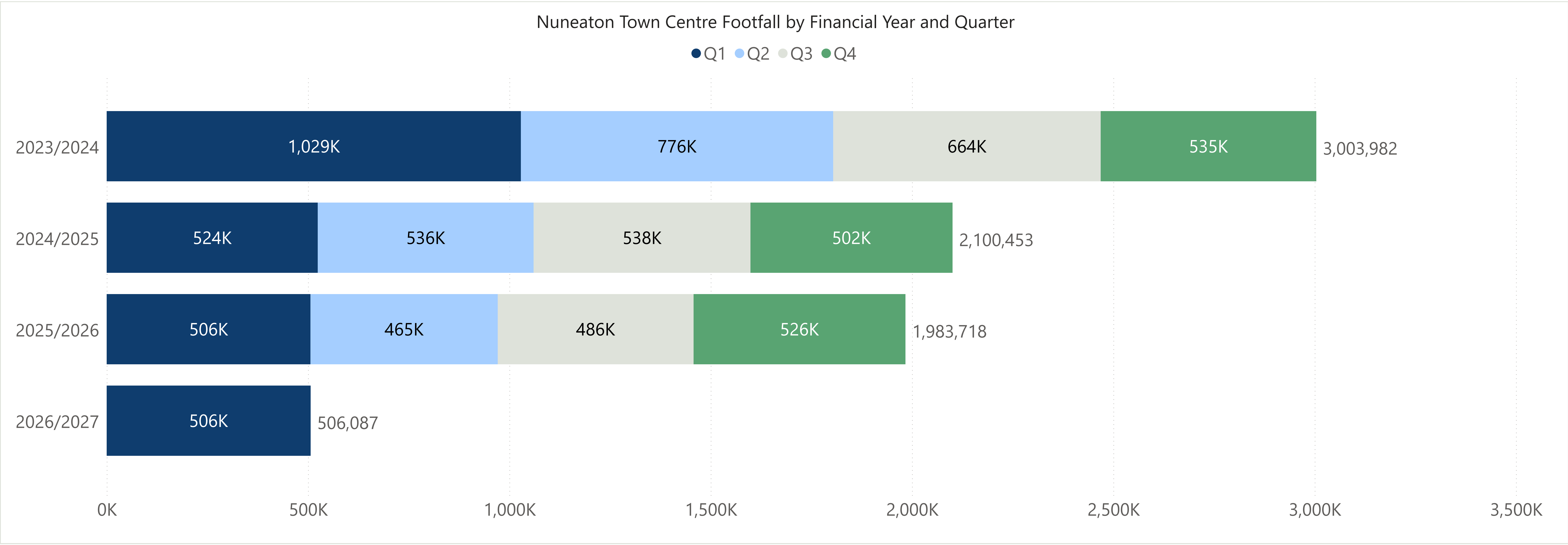

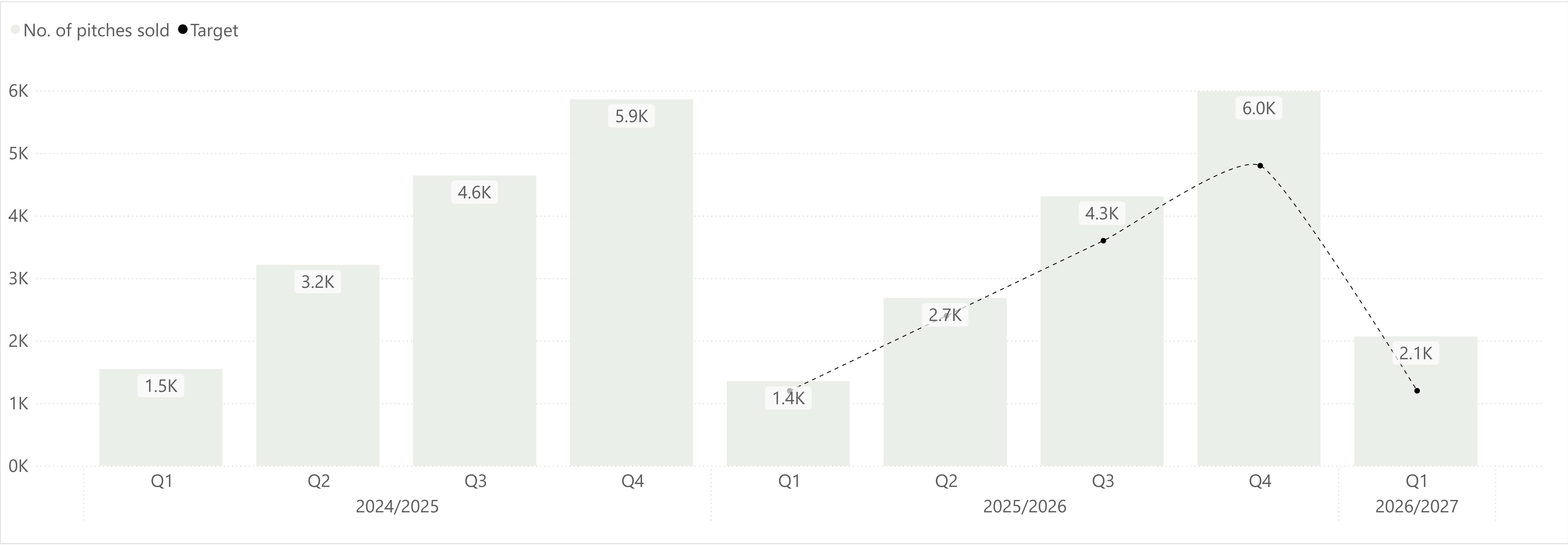

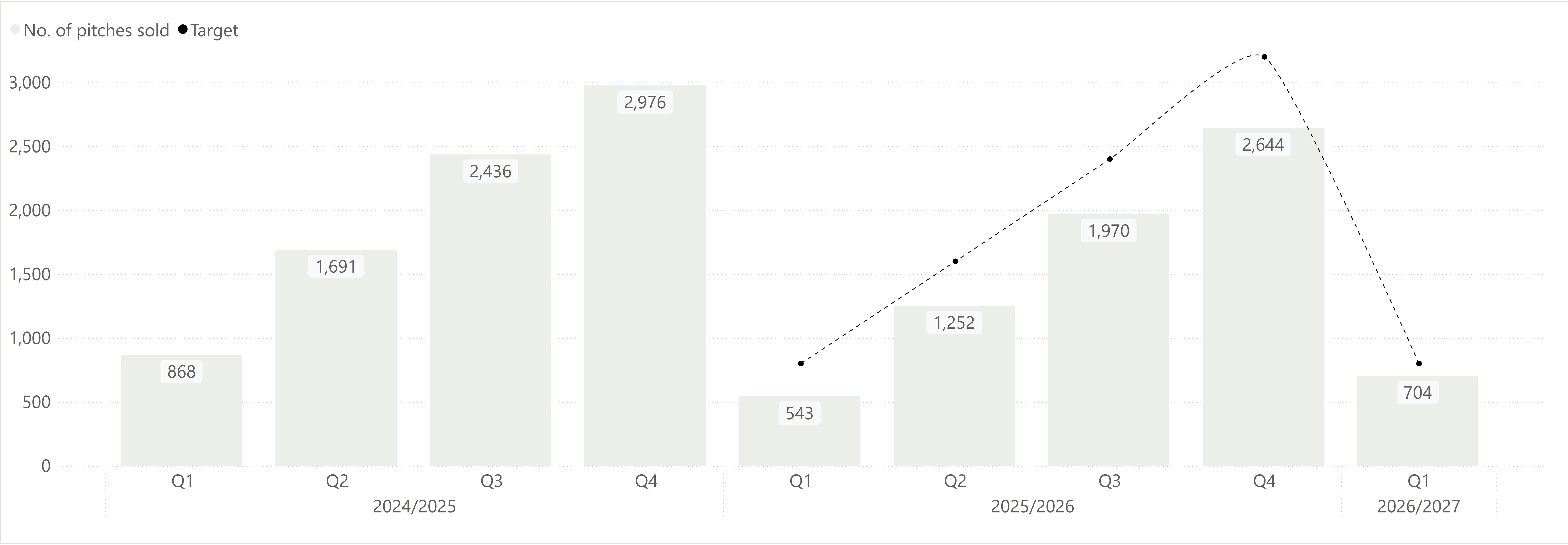
