PARAGRAPH 16 – SPECIAL URGENCY

Notice has been given to the Chair of the Internal Overview and Scrutiny Panel that a decision needs to be taken by Cabinet as a matter of urgency, seeking a general exception to allowing NBBC to go out to tender for CCTV at the earliest opportunity.

CCTV, wireless connectivity and maintenance contract – Procurement Exercise

The Council wishes to undertake a procurement exercise to procure one supplier to undertake the following provisions:

- Replacement of obsolete CCTV cameras within the borough of Nuneaton and Bedworth cooperated by the Council
- Conversion to a wireless based solution
- Ongoing annual maintenance, support and reactive repairs where applicable

It is strategically viable to collate all three requirements into one contract. The estimated value of the contract £400,000.

The report is requested not for call in due to the timescales involved in the procurement process and its implications on the potential savings available as a result of moving from fibre to wireless CCTV network.

In view of the nature of the decision, this is a key decision which has not been included in the Forward Plan.
