Advice about evictions and the ending of a tenancy

This leaflet gives advice about the ending of, or eviction from, different types of tenancies, such as Social Housing tenancies and Assured Shorthold tenancies.

What type of tenancy do I have?

If you are privately renting, most people will have an Assured Shorthold tenancy, if you are unsure what type of tenancy you have, then this <u>tool on the Shelter website</u> is very useful to help you find out.
