FIRE EVACUATION NOTICE

IF A FIRE BREAKS OUT IN YOUR ACCOMMODATION:



Leave the property where the fire is straight away. Close the door behind you.



Do not stop to put the fire out or collect belongings.



Sound the alarm by using a call point or calling the fire service – **DIAL 999 or 112**.



If there is a lift do not use it!



Wait outside at the assembly point, away from the building.

IF YOU SEE OR HEAR OF A FIRE IN ANOTHER PART OF THE BUILDING:



The building is designed to contain a fire in the flat where it starts – this means it will usually be safe for you to stay in your own flat if the fire is elsewhere.



You must leave immediately if smoke or heat affects your home, or if you are told to leave by the fire service



If there is a lift do not use it!



If you are in doubt - get out and wait outside at the assembly point, away from the building.
