The facility is open year round; October –March midweek evenings, weekends all day, April-Sept Sun am and Monday evenings. The facility does not open longer as Trustees all have other employment or businesses. There is no school usage, Hinckley College has booked nets in the past. Bounce considers that cost is an issue for schools. No other sports take place at the facility, although it would lend itself to other sports such as football, netball. However, there would be a likely clash with demand for cricket in the winter months. There are issues of sustainability. The facility requires new equipment and funding to continue.
